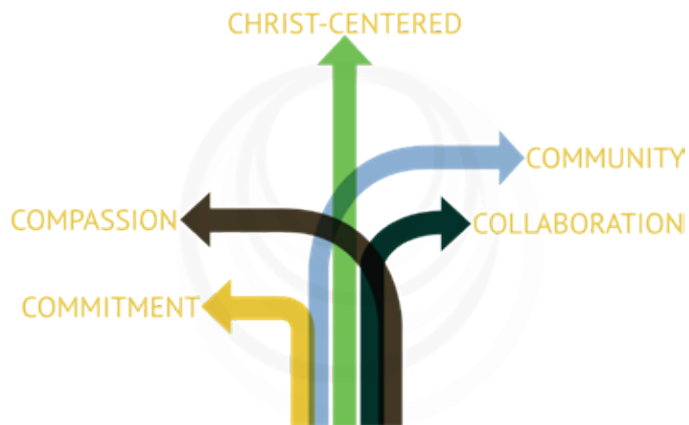

Harmony Community Development Corporation was established as a 501 (c) 3 non-profit organization in 2001 by Concord Church. We were organized to stimulate the development of affordable housing, create business ownership, and increase social services. Dr. Bryan Carter reestablished Harmony in 2007 in order to make strides towards impacting the community through resources, social services, and programs.

Harmony targets residents of the South Oak Cliff area of Dallas, with additional concentration throughout the southern sector of Dallas, including Best Southwest cities of Cedar Hill, DeSoto, Duncanville, and Lancaster.
